

Today, on this Summer Tuesday: God the Creator is always with you!



Gather your children together and read Psalm 139:1, 5, 7,18b

“O LORD, you have examined my heart and know everything about me. . . You go before me and follow me. You place your hand of blessing on my head. . . I can never escape from your Spirit! I can never get away from your presence. . . And when I wake up, you are still with me.”

Application: Talk with your children about their Loving God who knows everything about them, because He made each one of them. He knows how they laugh, He knows their voice, He knows when they cry. . . He knows if they are afraid. He sees them, everywhere they go and He goes with them. He goes ahead of them. . . He goes behind them, and He is with them. He is with them when they wake up in the middle of the night. . . Their Mighty, Almighty God, their Creator, watches over them. . . just like parents watching over the household. And He watches over you!

We can be thankful that God goes with us everywhere we go. Talk about places you go where you are glad that God goes too? How does it make you feel to know that God knows you so well? That He watches over you? Thank Him for always being with you.

If there is an absence of a family member due to divorce, death, or separation of any kind, remind your child that God never goes away, never leaves, and never has to travel. Remember the words that God gave to Moses in Deuteronomy 31:7. . . “The Lord your God will go with you. He will not leave you or forget you.”
