



**Today, on this Summer Wednesday:  
God the Creator provides for His Creation...**

**Gather your children together and read Genesis 1:29-31**

**“Then God said, “Look, I have given you every seed-bearing plant throughout the earth and all the fruit trees for your food. And I have given every green plant as food for the wild animals, the birds in the sky, and the small animals that scurry along the ground – everything that has life. . . Then God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was very good.”**

**Application: Spend the rest of the week observing the elements of Creation which interest your child. Take every opportunity to “intentionally” notice and to talk about God’s magnificent work. He is the Master Artist, the Creator of all animals, all plants, all landscape, all rivers, all oceans, all rocks, all valleys, all mountains. . . Count the stars. . . Chase the clouds. . . Smell the flowers. Encourage your child to create a work of art to reflect the beauty they see in God’s Creation. And on Sunday, encourage your family to spend time to honor God, your Creator!**

**Remind your child that God provides food and places to sleep for all animals, all sea creatures, and fish, and for the birds. He provides for all of His Creation because that is who He is. . . The Provider for His Creation.**
