Gather your children together and read Psalm 146:6

"He made heaven and earth, the sea, and everything in them. He keeps every promise forever."

Application:

One of the most important aspects in healthy and trustworthy relationships is one's ability to keep a promise. Think about the people in your life who you know you can count on, no matter what. Those people who are dependable to do what they say they will do... who will stay in your moments with you, doing life with you. For manyof us, the list may be too short; I know like you do that it is never is it too long...

Try as we might, we all really mess up with promise-keeping, at some point... even with the best of intentions. Today, talk with your children about the importance of promise-keeping. Talk about the successes and the failures which have occurred in the life of your family, and be sure and add the importance of forgiveness!

Then, tell them the most wonderful news! The Everlasting, Eternal, Forever God is their Promise-Keeper. He keeps His Promises to His people forever, and for always...never breaking one... and His very best Promise was fulfilled in His Son Jesus Christ.

Talk about times when you and your family experienced the fulfilled promises of God.

Talk about times when you waited...perhaps you are waiting now. Remind your precious ones that God keeps His promises...And, His promises are always the BEST WAY...and worth the wait!
